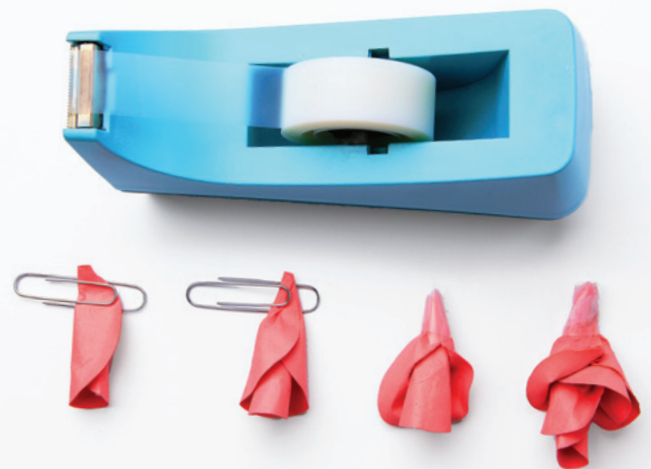
supplies

- Card Stock
- Circle Punch (1 1/2")
- Tape
- Paper Clips
- Plate
- Water
- Assorted Ribbon of Your Choice
- Chenille Stems

1. Punch a series of circles using circle punch.



2. Place each circle in a shallow dish of water for a second or two—just long enough to get the paper slightly wet, not soggy. Then, gently crinkle as shown. Let bloom dry.



3. Carefully shape the flower, working layer by layer. Start with a single circle, formed into a loose roll. Then, layer additional circles around it until you achieve the desired shape and fullness of bloom. Wrap clear tape around the base of the bloom to secure.



4. Twist a pair of chenille stems tightly together, and use clear tape to secure them to the rose. Then, wrap the stem with wired ribbon, taking care to cover the base of the bloom.



4. Tie the stems together with the ribbon of your choice.
