How to Create a Flower Brooch

SUPPLIES: Plastic Shopping Bags, Pin Back, Stapler, Scissors, Hot Glue



1. Cut 6-8 plastic squares from shopping bag, each measuring approximately 8" x 8".



2. Neatly stack the squares and accordion fold the stack as shown, creating 3/4" to 1" folds.



3. Fold the stack in half, as shown. Staple near the folded end, approximately 1/2" away from actual fold.



4. Use scissors to round off the corners for the look of a traditional flower—or cut corners into a point for an edgier look.



5. Carefully pull the layers apart to form a flower, fluffing the plastic petals, as needed. Use hot glue to adhere the pin back to the flower.
