

*Hair wear turns eco-chic for this trendsetting project. Crafted from recycled plastic shopping bags, it's unlike anything you'll find in a store. Create your very own hip headband by following these simple steps...*



**SUPPLIES:** Plastic "Fabric", Scissors, Sewing Machine, Elastic Cording, Eyelets, Eyelet Setter, Embroidery Floss, Button, Embossing Heat Tool

*Before you begin, check out the link to learn how to make plastic "fabric".*

1. Cut an approximately 9" x 2 1/2" piece from the plastic fabric. This will serve as the band.
2. Use sewing machine to add a decorative zigzag stitch to the outer edges of the band.
3. From a new plastic bag (with no fusible web applied), cut several circles to form the flower accent. Use the embossing heat tool to fuse the circles together and gently curl the edges.
4. Use embroidery floss to stitch and secure both the flower accent and the button to the band.
5. Set an eyelet in each end of the band.
6. Measure cording to the desired length, and thread each end of the cording through an eyelet. Knot the ends of the cording to hold it in place.
